-The Komodo Dragon is native to many islands in Indonesia including Rinca, Flores, Gili Motang, Gili Dasami, and of course the Islands of Komodo. It is most comfortable in environments such as savannas, tropical forests, and grasslands.

- In an effort to save the species, the Indonesian government built the Komodo National Park as a place that the dragons could live in protection.

- The International Union for the Conservation of nature and Natural Resources (IUCN) has placed the Komodo Dragon on its Red List of Threatened Species because it is in risk of extinction. Currently,

there are less than 5000 Komodo Dragons in existence.

- In regards to its senses, the Komodo Dragon has a weak ability to hear and a poor ability to see. It has no sense of taste since it has no taste buds. However, it has a very strong sense of smell.

- It is the largest lizard species still in existence and can grow to be two to three metres in length!

How to Play

The Objective

- Komodo Kid is a single player game.

- The objective of the “Komodo Kid” game is to get Komodo Kid back to The Komodo National Park in Indonesia safely by passing three levels:

- Level 1: Grassland in the daytime
- Level 2: Rainforest at nighttime
- Level 3: Savanna during sunset

- The player is successful by achieving points by spitting venom at enemies, jumping on top of coins and enemies, where appropriate.

- The player loses the game by running into

an enemy or falling into an area of water.

Keys to Remember

- The left arrow key will make Komodo Kid move to the left.

- The right arrow key will make Komodo Kid move to the right.

- The up arrow key will make Komodo Kid jump upward.

- The spacebar will make Komodo Kid spit venom.

Successful Completion

The top 50 scores achieved from playing Komodo Kid will be displayed on the Top Score (omit hyperlink) page of the site.

After the player completes the game with a perfect score or a score higher than the lowest score already displayed on the site, he or she will be prompted to type in three initials to be displayed with his or her score on the website.
